### Irish Secondary Schools CheckMate Finals 2013

The 2013 Secondary Schools CheckMate Finals was held Friday, 12-April-2013 at the South Court Hotel, Raheen, Limerick. Teams had qualified from Regional play-offs held around the country and 18 teams turned up, 72 players.

Many of the country's strongest Junior players were playing on some team, including the current u19's and u16's Irish Champions.

Chess clocks were used in all games with a fast Rapidplay time setting of 15 minutes each. Six round were played in total with a short break after round 4.

The tournament was run as an Individual swiss tournament, with Individual team members scores making a team score. Team members are barred from playing each other by the Computer software, thereby not causing any distortion to the results.

There were three clear team places and three clear Individual places, and no blitz play-off's were necessary.

Christian Brothers College, Cork took 1<sup>st</sup> place by a single half point to newcomers, Crescent College from Limerick who came 2nd. Castleknock College (Leinster Champions) came 3<sup>rd</sup> wth only 1.5 game points behind the winners – the results were that close. (This was the winners 4<sup>th</sup> consequetive win)

Zaran Butt from Castleknock College took the Individual prize beating several Irish International players along the away. He was followed closely by Chris Young and Hugh Doyle who took 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places respectively on tie-break.
